# A Dedication to Dialysis for 50 Years: *Proud & Passionate!*

In April 1974, an independent testing body in nephrology was established - BONENT - the Board of Nephrology Examiners Nursing Technology.

50 years later, over 30,000 dialysis nurses and technicians have taken a BONENT exam. Today, over 8,000 are currently certified in the United States and 11 other countries and growing.

Over those 50 years BONENT has evolved to now include 5 credentials in dialysis:

- **CHT**: Certified Hemodialysis Technologist (English & Spanish)
- CHBT: Certified Hemodialysis BioMedical Technologist
- **CHN**: Certified Hemodialysis Nurse
- CPDN: Certified Peritoneal Dialysis Nurse
- **CHWS**: Certified Hemodialysis Water Specialist

#### **Major Recent Developments**

- NNCO Joins BONENT: In early 2021, The National Nephrology Certification Organization became part of BONENT, which agreed to accept all CCNT, CBNT, and CDWS certificants, as well as providing a path for their recertification to becoming BONENT members.
- **BONENT Adds CHWS Exam**: BONENT added to its four exams by offering the NNCO Dialysis Water certification, but the acronym changed to Certified Hemodialysis Water Specialist (CHWS). This addition brings the total exams offered by BONENT to five.
- **CHT Spanish Version:** This year we will be celebrating 10 years since we started offering a Spanish version of our CHT exam.
- **30<sup>th</sup> Seminar**: BONENT annually hosts 2-3 Regional Seminars and 1-2 Virtual Seminars to help its members obtain Continuing Education credits toward their 4-year recertification requirements. In 2021, we had our first, one-day Virtual Seminar. It was a great success, with over 300 attendees, followed by 4 total seminars in 2022, with over 700 attendees in total, including



BONENT and NNCO certified members, and non-members too! Our next seminar will be our 30<sup>th</sup> since 2012!

- 2024 Regional Seminar Dates Established: BONENT recently announced the dates of the 2024 Regional Seminars:
  - MidWest Regional Seminar in Chicago IL, Sunday June 9<sup>th</sup>
  - Northeast Regional Seminar in Newark NJ, Sunday August 25<sup>th</sup>
  - Virtual Seminar: November 10<sup>th</sup>
- A Growing Website: In its continuing efforts to stay current and communicate with its members and future exam applicants, BONENT revamped its website to a completely new look, and continues to update with and easier-to understand content at <a href="https://www.BONENT.org">www.BONENT.org</a> with more than 170 web pages.
- **The BONENT Store**: BONENT promotional items are always a hot commodity at conferences and seminars. They have recently been made available for purchase on the BONENT website;
- **Minimum Work Experience Change:** After listening to our members, ESRD partners and renal community, in 2018, BONENT changed the minimum work experience to sit for the CHT (Certified Hemodialysis Technologist) and the CHBT (Certified Hemodialysis BioMedical Technologist) exam, from twelve months to six months.
- Watch later in 2024: BONENT Online Continuing Education will debut, where we will provide over 30 single-hour webinars to purchase and view to help our members gain CE hours for their recertification.
